OPEN FLOOR:

Topic 1: The September ASC

Chad: The September ASC is now scheduled for September 4th which is Labor Day weekend. It's as simple as making a procedural motion in new business. September 11th is an NA event but I just wanted to bring it up and put the thought in people's heads to see if we wanted to leave it as is but Labor Day weekend is a potential for people to be gone.

Topic 2: Using the monthly ledgers.

Steven: We did pass a motion to use a monthly ledger report created by Josh and submit that. With this revision I did, this form can be found in the ASC guidelines packet and Sam will add them to the SENANA ASC website.

Cameron: Since H&I don't have an out should we still be submitting this in our report?

Steven/Chad: YES

Steven: You account for your expenses on this form. You would carry your balance from last month and state how much you are putting out.

Josh: This will be based on your budget that was approved.

Topic 3: Traditions

Howard: This has to do with regarding our 12 steps and 12 traditions being on meeting lists. I sent Sam an email about this. Back in the day, for there to be extreme changes made to the meeting lists were to come back to this body. For years they were on the meeting lists and for the newcomer, one of their first looks at this program is the 12 steps and 12 traditions. I have a meeting list back from 1995 or 1996 with small print of the 12 steps and traditions. I am feeling hurt and upset.

Sam: I have looked through every piece of guidelines we have had for 30 years, there is nothing that states this service body needs to make decisions about the information on the meeting lists. The decision to make these changes went through this subcommittee.

Chelsea: I know personal feelings don't really matter, especially in the name of business, but I don't think it's the area's responsibility to cover literature

Nick: The meeting list isn't here to save my life, the NA Literature is.

Angelo: In the institution I was in the meeting list was the first piece of literature I saw. I didn't have NA literature at my disposal. Sometimes all we had was a glance at the 12 steps and 12 traditions on the meeting lists. I didn't have other NA resources at my disposal.

Cameron: I really see both sides of it. Times have changed. Ten years ago is way different, they didn't have access to it but today everybody has phones. I think if someone wants to change the meeting lists they should be a part of the PI subcommittee. It was voted on.

Chad: I tried to look at our policy and there is nothing in our policy that states we determine what is on the meeting lists. It would be my opinion that if you want to be involved in what is on those meeting lists to join up and be involved on that subcommittee. We could create a long motion; those are your options at this body. The easier solution is to become a member of that body and influence the meeting list there.

Steven: Under the PI section it says how to handle new meetings to be included. That is what it says from a policy standpoint.

John: The point of reference I have is the Regional meeting list, other than meetings and websites there is nothing of reference except websites, meetings, and the definition of each area's responsibility.

Brian: I see both sides of it, but I like the idea of it being on there. It's not a matter of whether it's legal or not, the subcommittees can make their own rules along as they are within the ASC guidelines.

Pat: As far as I can remember, if PI is doing what they are supposed to be doing (making sure we have a meeting list) the design is up to PI, if you want to change that you go to PI and change that. For H&I, if you have an issue with receiving information, you would attend an H&I meeting and address your issue there.

Howard: I didn't even know the PI committee was happening. I live 19 miles away. I don't have access to the PI subcommittee. This has worked for years; not including the 12 steps and 12 traditions on a meeting list is not reaching out to the newcomer.

Lori: We have trusted servants in subcommittees for a reason and we entrust them to do their job. If you want to make changes you need to attend those subcommittees. If we are bringing everything back to the area what's the point of the subcommittee in the first place.

Sam: I just want to make a point of clarification. This was not changed because it didn't fit. It was taken off; I initiated it, and sent it back to every member on the PI committee. We believe that these two pieces of literature were what a newcomer needed to see. Thank God this isn't 40 years ago. Things change, but this was not done as a personal whim.

Topic 4: Literature & ASC Bank Account

Steven: With the new 10% surcharge for shipping, some of that could accrue throughout the year. Literature set up guidelines of how to handle that. How are we going to track that as being a part of the general fund? With all of that money coming in, how do we know the difference between the ASC additional charge and the ASC fund?

Nick: I talked with Eric and spoke with Josh and since all the money is going to area; if that surplus were to accrue it would already be in area. Since it's going to the one bank account it's already with area.
