OLD BUSINESS-None.

OPEN FLOOR

- ❖ **Region Donation:** Shellie-As of now we have about \$2,000 in our account and policy states that anything over 3-months operating expenses should go on to Region. Over the last 11 months, the average it costs to run this area is \$844 for 3 months. I feel strongly about moving some of this money on to Region. Jeff-I currently have a Region donation check wrote out today for \$1,200.
- ❖ **Smoking/Vaping:** Jon-I saw people vaping on the property when I got here. We have been told it is a condition of keeping this building that smoking and vaping CAN NOT take place on their property. Bekka-There is an exit door you can take to go across the street if you need to smoke or vape. Regarding smoking or vaping in your vehicle, consensus please don't, as our vehicles are still on their property.
- ❖ **Independence Center:** Sam-They are looking for members from NA to help transition clients that are getting ready to leave treatment and who have chosen Narcotics Anonymous as their fellowship. They would like some members that are willing to provide their phone number, possibly meet face-to-face, and serve as a point of contact for meeting and fellowship information when they leave the treatment center. We currently do not have a service that provides this. Kimberly-Is this something that we could do as a temporary ad-hoc for 6 months and see how it goes? Jan-We are spreading ourselves thin as it is and have several positions that are still unfilled. Sam- I share your concerns. And this facility takes clients to outside meetings, so these clients have the ability on their own what the Independence Center is asking for. They can get the list that is handed out to newcomers, see someone at the meeting and ask them who they are and if they are on the list. Also, we don't know if Herman has brought this to H&I yet to discuss what options they may have. Steve- There are institutions to which we currently are unable to fulfill our commitments. Shellie-In the past we had a conflict with this entity (Independence Center) where they were saying they have NA meetings; we had to clarify that we are separate. To me, this would blur that line. And if we do this for them, what's to say we shouldn't do it for every treatment center? Brian-I agree with Steve that we need to get back to fulfilling the commitments we already have. Ethan-
