Policy did not meet last week. We will be meeting after area today to work on PR's guidelines as the committee has asked me to work on them. I did purchase a case of paper to print the Policy in the future so it does not cost as much.

**NRCNA CONVENTION ADHOC:**

To SENANA and NRSCNA,

Below is a bit of information I was able to gather from the Cornhusker Marriott as a potential host for NRCNA 40, which is the venue that I would propose our Area, Region, and ultimately our Groups should consider as the hosting site:

- 1.) The tentative weekend will be September 27th, 28th, 29th, of 2024 (please note: Because the 2024 Husker Football schedule isn't fully released, the hotel has agreed that once the 2024 Husker Football schedule is released, if a home game happens to be during this schedule time frame, the hotel will make reasonable accommodations to reschedule the event)
- 2.) The convention space is going to cost \$3,000 and this includes a ballroom, two separate breakout rooms for workshops, and a breakout room for our vendors and raffle items, as well as a room for storage. All convention space is easily accessible, in one main area, on the lower level of the hotel.
- 3.) The food and beverage minimum is \$5,000 which will be met by purchasing the banquet meals on Saturday night, as well as coffee and other refreshments throughout the weekend.
- 4.) The hotel has offered a discounted room rate of \$115.00 per night, and we will agree to a block of 75 rooms Friday night and 75 rooms Saturday night. We will get 1 complimentary room per 50 revenue generated rooms utilized by our attendees (typically those complimentary rooms are given to main speakers to offset the costs)
- 5.) There is plenty of parking in the parking garages, however, the parking garages are owned by the city, not the Cornhusker Marriott, therefore parking costs will have to be

assumed by anyone choosing to park in the parking garages. The first hour is free, then \$1.25 per hour, or \$11.25 per day.

6.) Jae J. from Lincoln, NE has voiced a willingness to be the NRCNA 40 Executive Chairperson. Rebekah H. from Lincoln, NE has voiced a willingness to be her Executive Vice Chairperson.

SENANA is ready to get to work! This is the same venue NRCNA 34 used in 2017 when it was in Lincoln, and it was a tremendous success. I have great faith it can be another successful convention in 2024 at this venue. I thank you for allowing me to serve!
