Exciting new PR effort: Our team has begun distributing white booklets to Little Free Libraries across Lincoln!

Unfortunately, our phoneline was down for an unknown period due to an expired debit card. Thanks to coordination between our IT Coordinator and Area Treasurer, it is now operational again.

We're experiencing a similar issue with our domain renewal. The account is under a name unfamiliar to any current subcommittee members. Our IT Coordinator is working hard to resolve this and get the website back online.
